

VILLAGE OF HALKIRK

The Village of Halkirk was established in 1912. In 2007, the Village of Halkirk had a current population of 113 persons.

Land Supply, Zoning and Road Network:

In 2006, the total area of the municipality is 72 hectares with 62 dwellings. The Village has a supply of readily serviceable land for residential, commercial and industrial use.

Zoning by-law allows for all types of industrial development, i.e., light, intermediate and heavy.

Municipal Planning and Infrastructure Information:

The Town is a member of the Shirley McClellan Regional Water Services Commission and receives its water from the regional waterline.

The Village collects sanitary sewage through a gravity collection system utilizing settling ponds for disposal. Solid waste is collected within the Village and disposed of in a Regional Landfill site.

High-speed internet is available in the Village.

Economic Development Initiatives:

The Village of Halkirk belongs to the Paintearth Economic Partnership Society (PEPS). The Society seeks to enhance and promote economic growth within the Paintearth region and in member communities. Its efforts focus on investment attraction, regional marketing and promotion, and on identifying economic diversification and opportunity. In 2006 PEPS developed a 3-year Business Plan supported by a formal Action Plan. Halkirk also has partnerships with both CAEP and BRAED for economic development.
